2015 - MISGA 2-MAN TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT

This year's championship tournament was contested on Thursday, August 27, at picturesque Norbeck Country Club in Rockville, MD. In early morning, fifty very talented old-timer 2-man teams (100 players) from 29 of MISGA's 60 member clubs hit the highways of Maryland, Delaware and Pennsylvania vying for the honor of being crowned MISGA's Gross and Net 2-Man Team Grand Champions. The weather goddess was very cooperative.



She provided ample sunshine and temperatures ranging in the low-to-mid 80s. Norbeck's course, as the norm, was in immaculate playing condition. The tee boxes, fairways, greens and roughs were a golfer's delight. From the forward (gold tees), the par 72 course measured 5,790 yards with a course rating of 68.1 and a slope of 124. Playing time ranged from "first in" at 4 hours, 40 minutes to "last in" at 5 hours, 15 minutes.

At conclusion of play, two golden-ager teams had tied for the *Gross Grand Champions* crown with a blistering score of 69. This required a sudden-death playoff. Hence, **Brian Lord** & **Charles Gouert** (Rookery North - Div. I) and **Tom Duvall** & **Nick Kraft** (Bretton Woods - Div IV) proceeded to hole #1 for the shootout. Finally, on hole #4, **Gouert's** approach shot landed about 1 foot from the cup. He sank the birdie putt capturing the **Gross Grand Champions** title, trophy and \$100 each gift certificate for his team.

Teammates **Goldstein** & **Spedden** each were presented with a **Net Grand Champion** trophy and a \$100 gift certificate for their golfing prowess.
