

2023 - MISGA 2-PLAYER TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT



On Monday, the 21st of August in 2023, the annual MISGA 2-Player Team Championship Tournament was held at the very scenic and picturesque golf course of Holly Hills Country Club located in the rolling hills of Ijamsville, MD. 54 talented teams (108 finalists) from 17 of MISGA's 35 member clubs traversed the highways of Maryland with hopes of becoming crowned MISGA's Gross and Net 2-Player Team Grand Champions.



The course tee boxes, fairways, greens and roughs were in exceptional playing condition. The only rough area was around the #9 green (pic above) - it was under course renovation. Play your ball from where it lies was the rule of the day. The weather was sunny, hot and humid. Players were advised to drink plenty of liquids.

A majority of the senior men played from the SGA blue tees: par 72, 5,972 yards with a course rating of 69.8 and a slope of 128. Less agile men played from the green tees: par 72, 5,315 yards with a course rating of 65.8 and a slope of 113. The ladies played from the red tees, par 73, 4,969 yards with a rating of 70.2 and a slope of 123. They received a +1 stroke adjustment. Playing time ranged from "first in" at 4 hours, 40 minutes to "last in" at 5 hours, 5 minutes.

GROSS GRAND CHAMPIONS

After all the scorecards had been collected, tabulated, attested and posted, teammates Tom Roullard & Dave Pitchure (Musket Ridge - Div. II) were crowned the 2023 Gross Grand Champions. They shot a hot 72 and defeated the runner-up team of Tom Duvall & Nick Krafft (Bretton Woods - IV) by 1 stroke. Team Roullard/Pitchur captured the coveted GGC title and each was awarded a crystal vase trophy and a \$110 pro shop gift certificate. In addition, they will not have to qualify for the 2024 2-Player Team Championship Tournament.
