On Monday, July 29, 2024, the annual MISGA 2-Player Team Championship Tournament was held at the very scenic and picturesque golf course of Holly Hills Country Club located in the rolling hills of Ijamsville, MD. 51 talented teams (102 finalists) from 18 of MISGA's 33 member clubs traversed the highways of Maryland



with hopes of becoming crowned MISGA's Gross and Net 2-Player Team Grand Champions.

The course tee boxes, fairways, greens and roughs were in exceptional playing condition. Play your ball from where it lies was the rule of the day. The weather was beautiful.

Many of the senior men played from the SGA blue tees: par 72, 5,972 yards with a course rating of 70 and a slope of 129. Less agile men played from the green tees: par 72, 5,315 yards with a course rating of 66.7 and a slope of 115. The ladies played from the red tees, par 73, 4,969 yards with a rating of 70.2 and a slope of 123. They received a +1-stroke adjustment.

After all the scorecards had been collected, tabulated, attested and posted, teammates Nick Krafft and Tom Duvall (Bretton Woods) were crowned the 2024 Gross Grand Champions. Team Krafft/Duvall captured the coveted Gross Grand Champion title by shooting a 1 under par gross 71. and Each was awarded a crystal vase trophy and a \$107.50 pro shop gift certificate. In addition, they will not be required to qualify for the 2025 2-Player Team Championship Tournament.

At the conclusion of tournament play, hotter than a firecracker teammates Victor Riche and Dave Kulick (Musket Ridge) captured the Net Grand Champion crown by shooting a fiery net 64.
